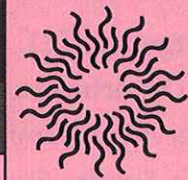

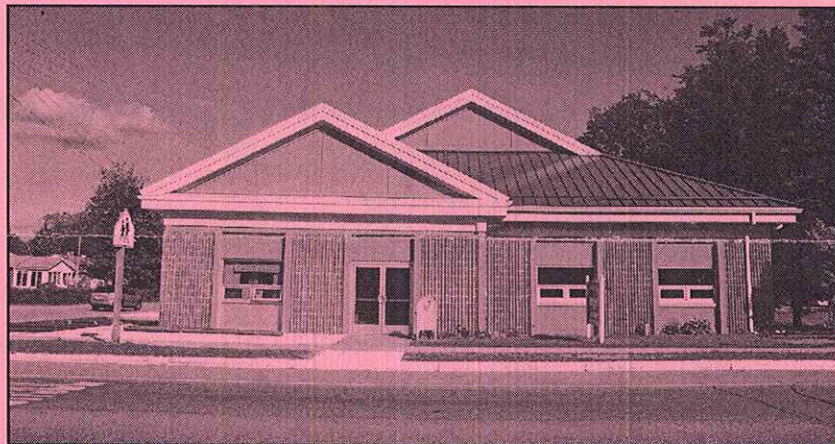

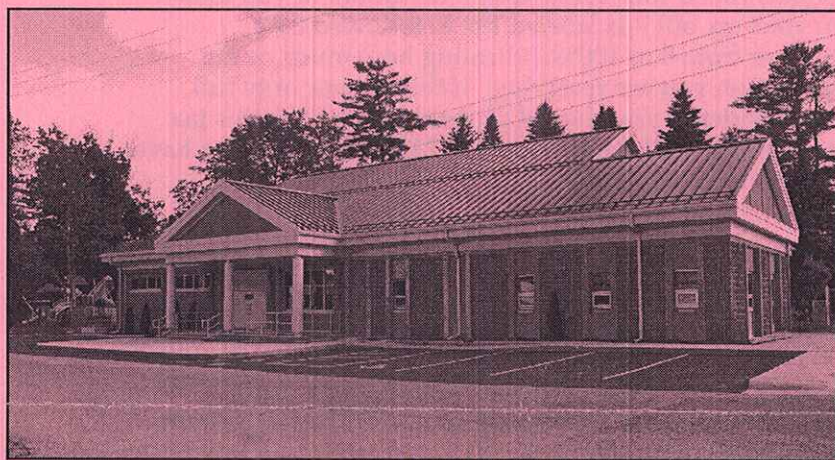
Nearing Completion! Township Hall and Library Project

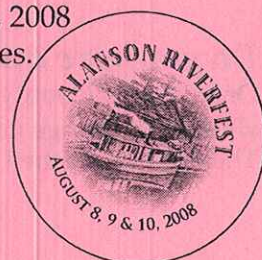

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

What is the Principle Residence Exemption?

Principle Residence Exemption is the new name for what is called the Homestead Exemption. If you look on your tax bill it is labeled P.R.E. followed by a number from 0 to 100% indicating how much of the exemption you are receiving. If this is your only full time residence you should probably be getting this tax exemption. Call the treasurer at 231-548-2142 if you have any questions.

Is an escrow company paying your property taxes for you?

Remember that only the property owner gets the original tax bills and receipts. The escrow companies receive a copy of the bill upon request.

Do you have a business in Littlefield Township?

In the State of Michigan there is a personal property tax to be paid by all businesses on their business equipment. As the business owner, you file a form every year on how much equipment you have and it's worth. If you do not file this form the assessor is required by law to estimate the amount you owe and file it for you. Contact the Assessor, Jim LaPeer, at 231-238-9606, with any questions.

Do you have an address change?

Report permanent address changes to the Treasurer. No seasonal address changes, please.

Do you have a name change?

Only Emmet County Equalization Department is allowed to change names on the tax roll. They can be reached at 231-348-1708.
