TAX QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

When is interest charged on my taxes?

Your tax payment must be in the possession of the treasurer, or postmarked by the due date, or interest will be added. There are no exceptions to this, so please plan ahead.

When is the penalty charged?

A 3% penalty on unpaid taxes is charged between the winter due date and the last day of Littlefield Township tax collection. This year that occurs between the dates of February 15, 2011 to February 28, 2011.

What happens after the last day of tax collection?

After February 28, 2011 all delinquent taxes must be paid to the Emmet County treasurer's office. Phone number: 231-348-1715.

How do I pay my taxes in person?

There are only two days each year that state law requires the treasurer or appointee to be available at a posted location between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. See below for the dates, times and location. Any other time must be by appointment.

Why didn't I get my yellow receipt?

Due to rising costs, taxpayers no longer are sent a receipt. If you need a receipt, please send a self-addressed, stamped envelope, or your fax number, along with your tax payment.

What is the Principle Residence Exemption?

Principle Residence Exemption is the new name for what used to be called the Homestead Exemption. If you look on your tax bill it is labeled P.R.E. followed by a number from 0 to 100% indicating how much of the exemption you are receiving. If this is your only full time residence you should probably be getting this tax exemption. Call the treasurer at 231-548-2142 if you have any questions.

Do you have an address or name change?

Report permanent address changes to the Treasurer. No seasonal address changes please. Only Emmet County Equalization Department is allowed to change names on the tax roll. They can be reached at 231-348-1708.

I have a business. What about personal property taxes?

All businesses pay taxes on their business equipment. It is in your best interest to file your own taxable amounts. If you do not, the assessor must do the estimation for you. Call the treasurer or assessor with any questions.
