Village of Alanson Purchases Access to River Park

A recently acquired parcel in the Village of Alanson will now allow public access to the Island Sanctuary Park, an island within the Crooked River that was donated to the Village in 2005. After applying for a grant, with the help of Little Traverse Conservancy, to the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund, a \$99,000 grant was approved in 2007. Funding allowed for the property's purchase just this past spring. The new property includes 500 feet on the Crooked River. Plans are for the Village of Alanson to request a Development Grant from the Trust Fund that will help complete a handicap accessible trail, boardwalk, fishing dock, and an overlook gazebo.
