# LITTLEFIELD TOWNSHIP SPECIAL MEETING BUDGET & PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX LEVY 2021-2022

After allowing the Board Members present to review the Agenda and the new Hay Lake Marina Operating Fund budget while eating the provided dinner, the Special Meeting for Budget & Public Hearing on Tax Levy was called to order at 6:15PM by Supervisor, Damien Henning. - BUDGETS WERE PREPARED FOR THE 2021-2022 YEAR: General Fund Revenue of \$531,243.00 and Expenses of \$849,420.00 with the deficit coming from General Fund- Fund Ballance. Sewer Fund Revenue of \$259,123.00 and Expenses of \$275,192.00 with the deficit coming from Sewer Fund- Fund Ballance. Fire Fund Revenue of \$180,320.00, and Expenses of \$188,742.00 with the deficit coming from Fire Fund- Fund Ballance. Cemetery Fund Revenue of \$1,014.00 and Expenses of \$5,000.00 with the deficit coming from Cemetery Fund- Fund Ballance. Hay Lake Marina Fund Revenue of \$20.00 and Expenses of \$12,000.00 with the deficit coming from Hay Lake Marina Fund- Fund Ballance. Oden Light Revenue of \$11,854.00, and Expenses of \$11,730.00. A New Hay Lake Marina Operating Fund will be established before the May 6, 2021 Regular Meeting with the following approved budget: Revenue of \$48,610.00 and Expenses of \$26,450.00. The Public Hearing was closed by D. Henning. The above Budgets were presented, revised, and Moved for approval by D. Morford, Second by K. Shomin. D. Henning asked if there was any further discussion: None asked if all in favor which Carried: 4 Yes, 0 No, 1 Absent.
- S. Festerling made the **Motion** to remove Agenda Item #11 Special Meeting of the Election Committee. It will be brought before the Township Board at the Regular April 6, 2021 Board Meeting. Second by D. Henning, Carried 4 Yes, 0 No 1 Absent. A special posting of Election Committee Meeting will be in the near future.
- D. Morford made a **Motion** to pay Sondra Festerling the Election Inspectors rate of \$16.00 per hour for any additional labor created from the passing of ballot proposal 18-3 on elections above the minimum statutory duties, to process Absent Voter Ballot Requests, and to be compensated for the additional labor it takes to do the work that was previously done by Emmet County for Littlefield Township. Second D. Henning, Carried 4 Yes, 0 No, 1 Absent.
- S. Festerling made a **Motion** to move the Regular May 2021 Board meeting to Thursday May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021 due to the May 4, 2021 Special Election being held during our normal Regular Board Meeting time. Second by D. Henning. Carried 4 Yes, 0 No, 1 Absent.
