

**LITTLEFIELD TOWNSHIP PUBLIC HEARING**  
**Littlefield Township Consumer Fireworks Ordinance No. 148**

Public Hearing and Meeting called to order by Damien Henning, Supervisor. A copy of the proposed Littlefield Township Consumer Fireworks Ordinance #148 was provided for review for anyone who wanted a copy.

D. Henning presented the reason for the public hearing is to get public comment on a Fireworks Ordinance that was presented to the Township by Trustee D. Morford. The township had their council look over the presented ordinance that was based on the Bear Creek Ordinance, and the actual ordinance came back to the township with changes to customize it for our township, which has led us to tonight's Public Hearing.
